Board Policy

State/Federal Government

Legislation

The Board shall be involved and informed of legislation which will impact or improve education for Scotland students and/or students in the State of Connecticut. The Board will work with its state association to this end.

State and Federal Aid

In order to bring the full benefit of state and federal aid programs to bear upon the needs of the school system, it is the policy of the Board to maintain close liaison with the State Department of Education and appropriate federal agencies, and to cooperate with them fully in providing improved educational services.

The Superintendent should pursue appropriate grant opportunities which would enhance the educational programs of the school system. The Superintendent shall notify the Board of the intention to submit grant proposals for funding. Board approval is required prior to grant acceptance.
